COMPETITION RULES

1. Entry is free and open to anyone except employees, agents or their immediate families of Renault South Africa ("Renault"), the Department of Economic Development of the Gauteng Provincial Government ("GPG") and Red Cherry Media Holdings ("Red Cherry").
2. All contestants must be over 18 years of age and in possession of a valid driver's license, free of any endorsements as well as a passport that is valid until at least 28 February 2009.
3. Persons who currently hold or who have at any time held a motor racing license issued anywhere in the world may not enter the competition.
4. This competition is open to residents of South Africa only.
5. No person with a criminal record is eligible to enter the competition. By entering the competition, contestants agree to the producers conducting a criminal record check.
6. Each contestant may submit only 1 entry for the competition.
7. Entries close at noon on 19 April 2008, and may be submitted to any Renault dealership in South Africa.
8. If any information furnished by a contestant is found to be false, the contestant will be disqualified.
9. If contestants are invited to the auditions in Johannesburg on 17/18 May, 24/25 May or 31 May/1 June 2008, they must travel to Johannesburg at their own expense.
10. The 6 finalists in the competition must be available to travel to France from 14 – 17 July 2008 and the competition winner must be available to travel to England from 27 July to 3 August 2008. Finalists who are unavailable to travel on these dates will forfeit their places as finalists.
11. The judges' decisions at all stages of the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into with any contestant.
12. Red Cherry, GPG and/or Renault may use any video footage, audio recordings or still photographs featuring any contestants in the Ultimate Grand Prix Drive television series and in any publicity material in any media.
13. By entering the competition, contestants:
 - 13.1 warrant that they are in sufficiently good health and of sufficient physical fitness to undertake all activities involved in the competition;

- 13.2 acknowledge that motorsport is dangerous and involves risks of injury;
- 13.3 warrant that their driving skills are of a sufficiently high standard to enable them to participate in the driving activities in the competition; and
- 13.4 indemnify Red Cherry, GPG, Renault and their proprietors, employees and agents against any claims of any nature whatsoever arising from any loss, damage or injury, of whatsoever nature and seriousness, that they may suffer at any time whilst participating in the competition and/or any activities involved therewith.
